CONFERENCE OVERVIEW

This conference is designed to provide updated information to improve patient treatment and communication. It is designed for physicians, specialists, nurse practitioners and physician assistants.

OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this conference, participants should be able to:

- Determine when and how to use long acting insulin in patients at risk for hypoglycemia.
- Define the term Suicide Attempt; identify types of lifetime baseline behaviors, examples of preparatory behaviors of a suicidal person and lethal and potentially lethal attempts; and effectively screen patients in their work setting.
